New Innisfail shopping centre to open Spring 09

Innisfail residents will have plenty of convenience services and food outlets at their fingertips when construction on Innisfail's new shopping centre is completed later this year.

Construction work at the commercial site, located on the corner of Tom Roberts Parade and Boardwalk Boulevard in Point Cook, began this month to create a new community hub and local shopping area within the Innisfail community.

The convenience-style village will offer more than 3,200sqm of shops, including an IGA supermarket, newsagent, florist, bakery, coffee kiosk and ATM facilities.

There will also be a range of food outlets, including pizza and pasta, fish chips, noodles and chicken, plus parking for 140 vehicles.
